**ACAENA (Sheepburr, New Zealand Burr)**

E-GC-R

*Dense evergreen hardy perennial, ideal as a GC plant. Colourful burr-like flower heads in late Summer.*

*Adaptable to sun and partial shade, tolerating hot, dry and poor conditions. Ideal in well drained soil.*

**ACANTHUS (Bear's Breeches)**

CF-DR-SPE-SU-BF-C-AGM

*A striking plant, which is a must in all herbaceous borders. Some varieties are semi-evergreen. Large deeply cut dark leaves, erect, then arching. Lovely mauve flowers with white tips on stiff spikes. Prefers full sun, but can be adaptable to full shade. Requires well-drained soil, but not tolerant to Winter wet.*

## ASTER (*Michaelmas Daisy*)

*Deciduous and evergreen shrubs with their 'daisy'-like flower heads in Summer and Autumn. Requires open position, but also adaptable to partial shade. Well-drained soils are essential. Good for cutting and attracting butterflies and bees. Prefers a sunny position.*
